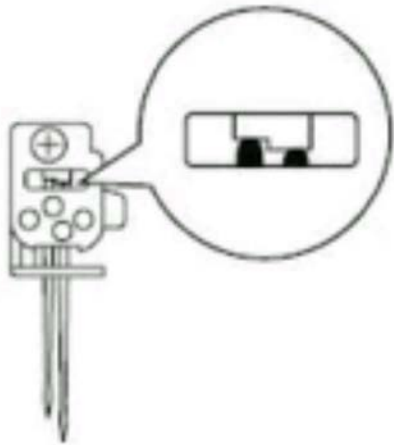


TROUBLESHOOTING SERGER NOISES : METAL ON METAL

Knocking means metal hitting metal, serging in this state just worsens the wear and damage to your machine. Stop and locate the noise. \$\$\$ the machine is telling you "pay me attention now, or pay \$\$\$ later." Unplug your machine so you do not accidentally serge yourself. Handwalk your flywheel on the right side of the machine towards you while watching the needle area and loopers. Remove the presser foot for a better view if needed. Shine a bright flashlight if needed. If the loopers are hitting each other or breaking needles, something is bent and may need replacement.

Change your needles and doublecheck they are flat backed into the housing and offset properly
